



**For more wildlife adventures:** take the footpaths north to the **North Downs**, west into the **Hampshire Downs**, south to the **South Downs** and **Butser Hill** or walk east to **Petersfield Heath and Pond**.

**Nb. Wrong alignment.** Footpath follows between double hedged path. **Badger dung pits and mammal paths.**

**Stroud village green.** Meadow flowers, butterflies, kestrels, buzzards, barn owls.

**Buzzards, red kites, lapwings, fieldfares (winter).**

**Furzefield Copse.** Ancient woodland, woodland flowers, roe deer. Private woodland, keep to footpath. **Take special care during forestry works to remove diseased ash trees.**

**Dangerous road crossing.** Use path alongside A3 instead for hedgerow trees, shrubs, flowers and insects.
